

Catechism Time!

Bible truths for teaching children

Question 48

What is the church?

A: A community elected (chosen) for eternal life and united by faith, who love, follow, learn from, and worship God together.

What it means...

The church is not a building. It is people chosen by God to be with him forever. They are united by faith and love, and worship God together.

Bible verses (Ephesians 4:4-6)

(The church is the body of Christ. There are many "one" because God wants his people to be united.)

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.


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
We will learn about 2 people who should not be happy at all.

Let's Open Up the Bible Philippians 4:4-13





- Paul wrote the letter to the Philippians. Paul wrote it when he was in a Roman prison, suffering for his faith in Jesus.
- But prison is no picnic → A Roman prison is anything but nice ⊗⊗
- → You would think that Paul would not be a happy camper.
- ☐ But the word "joy" (and its variants) appear 15 times in the letter!
- → What is Paul's secret of remaining joyful despite his poor circumstances? Let's find out...

Philippians 4:4-13

⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: rejoice! ⁵ Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. ⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.



Paul shows us 3 secrets for joy

(Don't try to read the words...they are too small)

⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: rejoice! ⁵ Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. ⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

- □ Paul tells us to rejoice (be joyful). To be joyful, we must PRAY AND GIVE THANKS (Read v.6 aloud).
- \Box When we pray \rightarrow we stop being anxious (worrying) because God knows what is best for us.
- lacktriangle When we give thanks ightarrow we won't forget the abundance God has already given us.

- 1. Paul was in prison. What could he give thanks for?
- 2. Why is prayer and giving thanks to God the secret for joy?
 - Hint A: What happens to your worries when you truly pray?
 - Hint B: When you give thanks, do you still focus on the things you lack \odot or what you have received from God already \odot ?

- □ Nowadays our minds are filled with the wrong thoughts or expectations. So we have nightmares and anxieties.
- Paul wants us to think about things that are pure, lovely, worthy of praise etc. → all about God's goodness
- Think about the flowers by the river or birds perching on a tree that you saw. They are the creative works of a good God. Think of Jesus' love for you; your sins are forgiven. Thank God for all these.
- □ What other thoughts would make you happy?

3rd Secret for Joy

- 11b I have learned to be content (satisfied) whatever the circumstances.
- I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty.

 I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want.
- ¹³ I can do everything through him who gives me strength.

Questions

- ☐ The word "content" appears twice. What does "content" have to do with joy?
- What do these verses say about the secret of Paul's joy? Why? (Hint: think about v.13)

You can have real joy too if you follow Paul's example and memorise this \rightarrow "I can do everything through him who gives me strength."

Background

The Philippian church supported Paul with money so he could tell others about Jesus.

Paul is grateful, but he does not need anything. He is content when he is well fed or hungry.

3 secrets for JOY when life feels rotten

- 1. Pray and give thanks to God \rightarrow stop worrying!
- 2. Always think about God's goodness ©
- 3. Being content and trusting God fully in everything

Joy vs. Happiness

- Happiness is an outward expression of a feeling. You can be happy if someone gives you a present on your birthday.
- 2. Joy is an inner feeling. It is deep in our hearts, not just on the surface. It does not depend on our situation. That's why Paul could be full of joy in prison.

We will now meet someone who has been paralysed for over 50 years after a tragic accident. She is still full of joy.

Let's meet Joni Eareckson Tada Singer, Painter, Author, Speaker, Activist

- ☐ At 17, she broke her neck in a diving accident
- ☐ She became a quadriplegic (paralyzed from the shoulders down)
- ☐ How can Joni have joy?
