Bible truths for teaching children

Question 3

- Q: How many persons are there in God?
- A: There are three Persons in one God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit

This means that

- 1. There is only one God ... not 3 Gods!
- 2. Each Person is <u>separate</u> from the other two
- 3. But all 3 are united in love

Bible reference (e.g. Luke 3:21-22; Mt 3:16-17)

When Jesus was baptised, the Spirit descended on him like a dove, and a voice came from heaven: "You are my son, whom I love..."

I am the True Vine


John 15:1-6

Jesus said, "I am the true vine; my Father is the gardener.

He cuts off every branch of mine that does not produce fruit. And he trims and cleans every branch that produces fruit so that it will produce even more fruit.

You are already clean because of the words I have spoken to you.

No branch can produce fruit alone. It must remain in the vine.



Jesus is the true vine

We are the branches



Jesus is the vine...

Remain in me, and I will remain in you. No branch can produce fruit alone. It must remain in the vine. It is the same with you. You cannot produce fruit alone. You must remain in me.

"I am the vine, and you are the branches. If a person remains in me and I remain in him, then he produces much fruit. But without me he can do nothing.

If anyone does not remain in me, then he is like a branch that is thrown away. That branch dies. "




"When I go away I will send the Helper to you.

When the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you into all truth.



- 2. If we remain in Jesus, we will produce fruit. What does producing fruit mean in our lives? (Hint: Consider fruit of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control; Galatians 5:22,23)
- 3. Why does the gardener (Father) cut off, trim and clean the branches (us)? Can each family member give an example where the Father trimmed and cleaned you?

- 4. Must a branch be always connected to the vine in order to produce fruit? Why?
- 5. Jesus said, "If a person remains in me and I remain in him, then he produces much fruit. But without me he can do nothing." Surely, I can still function as a person without Jesus, can't I? What exactly did Jesus mean by "Without me he can do nothing"?
- 6. Today's Catechism teaches that there is one God in 3 Persons. Do you see this truth in the bible verses (John 15-16) we read earlier?
- 7. From today's bible reading, did you learn something about the Holy Spirit? What is it that you learned?
