Catechism Time!

Bible truths for teaching children

Question 9

Q: What does God require in the 1st , 2nd and 3rd commandments?

A: First, that we know God as the only true God.

Second, that we avoid all idolatry.

Third, that we treat God's name with fear and reverence.

What is Idolatry?

Idolatry is...when we place something ahead of God in our lives

Bible verse (Deuteronomy 6:13-14)

Respect the Lord your God. Serve only him. Make your promises in his name.
Do not worship other gods as the people around you do.



Mary's Story

John 20:1-18



Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the entrance.

Now Mary stood outside the tomb crying. As she wept, she bent over to look into the tomb and saw two angels in white, seated where Jesus' body had been, one at the head and the other at the foot. They asked her, 'Woman, why are you crying?'

'They have taken my Lord away,' she said, 'and I don't know where they have put him.'

At this, she turned round and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not realise that it was Jesus.

He asked her, 'Woman, why are you crying? Who is it you are looking for?'

Thinking he was the gardener, she said, 'Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have put him, and I will get him.'

Jesus said to her, 'Mary.'

She turned towards him and cried out in Aramaic, 'Rabboni!' (means 'Teacher').

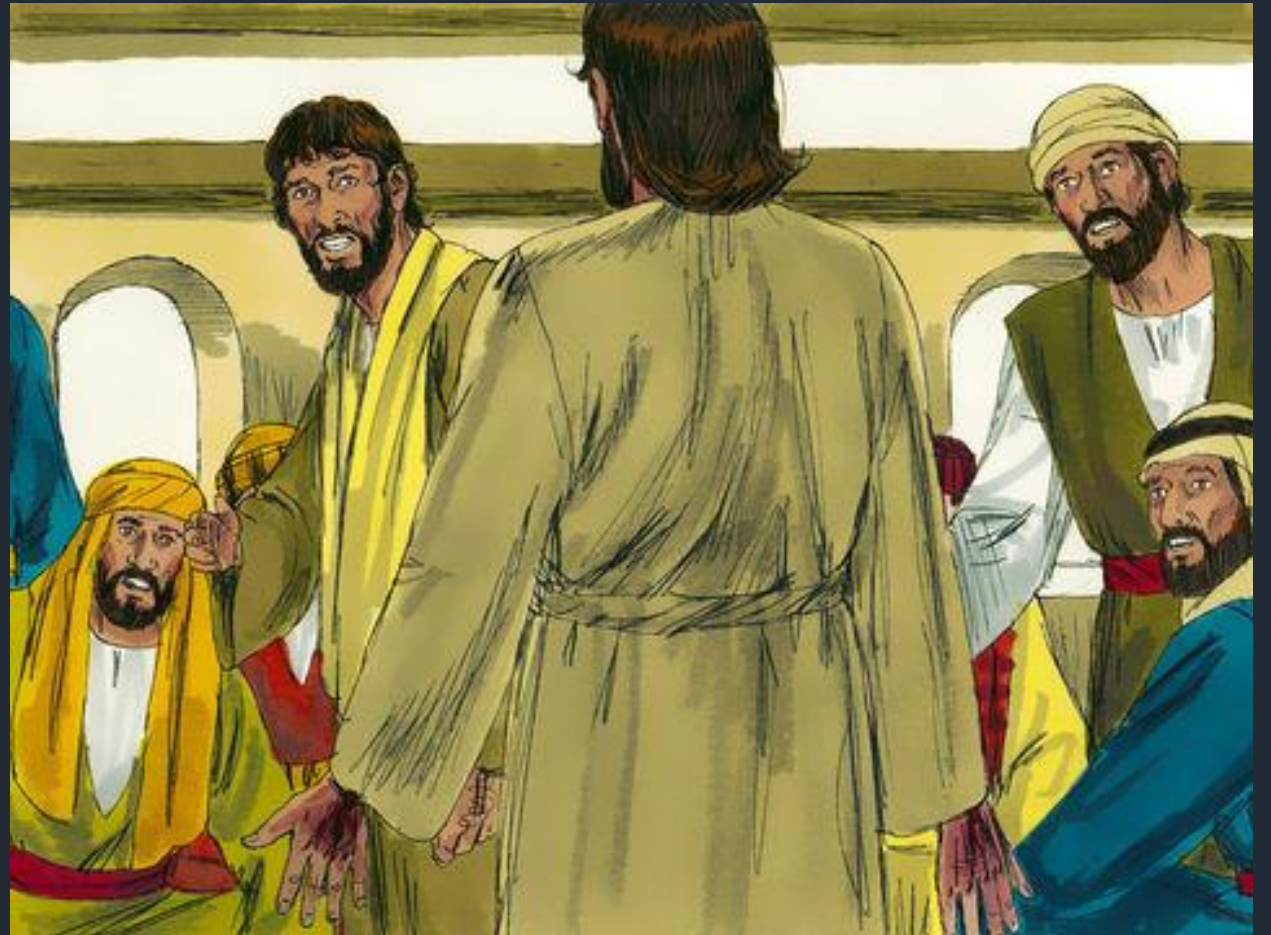

John 20:24-29

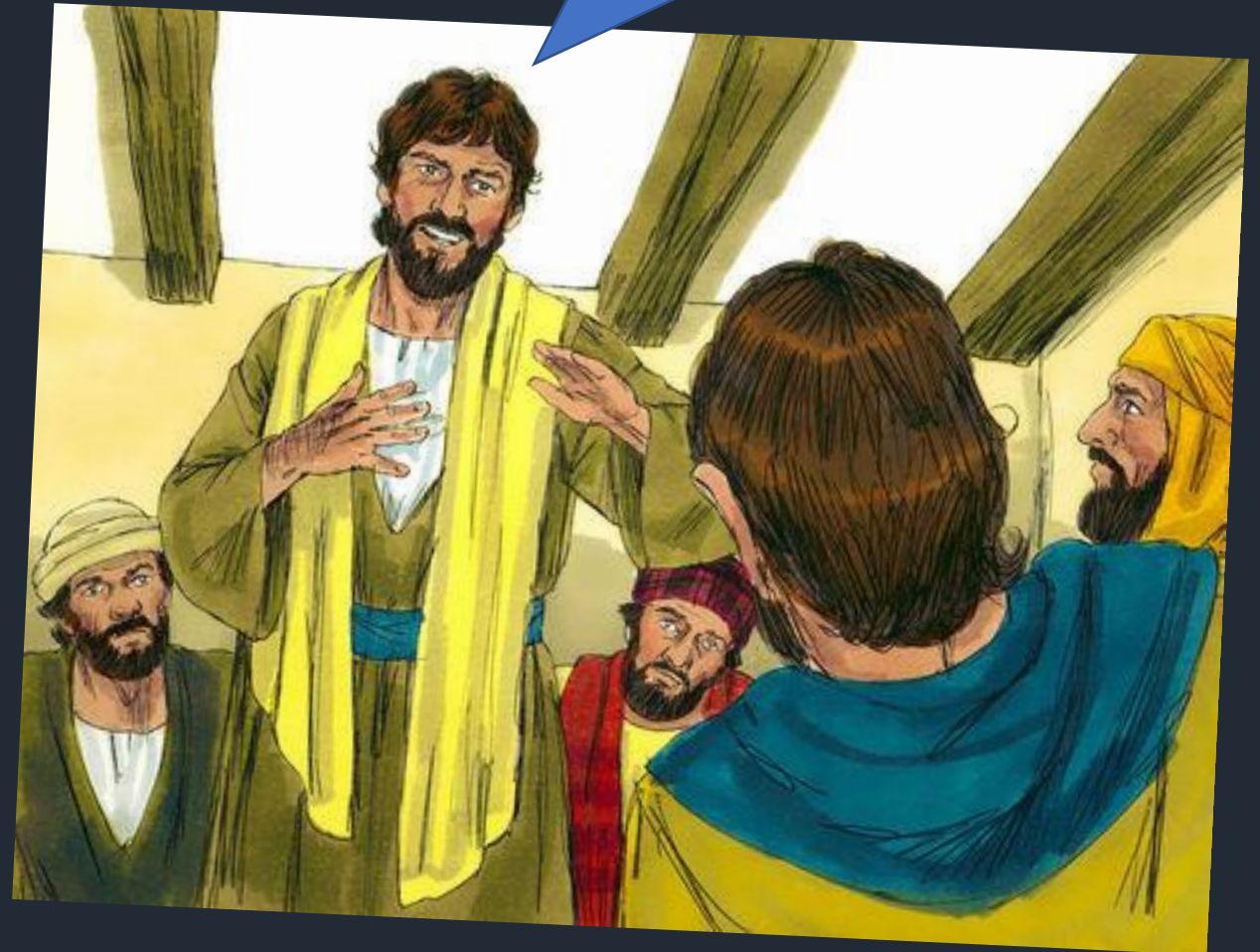


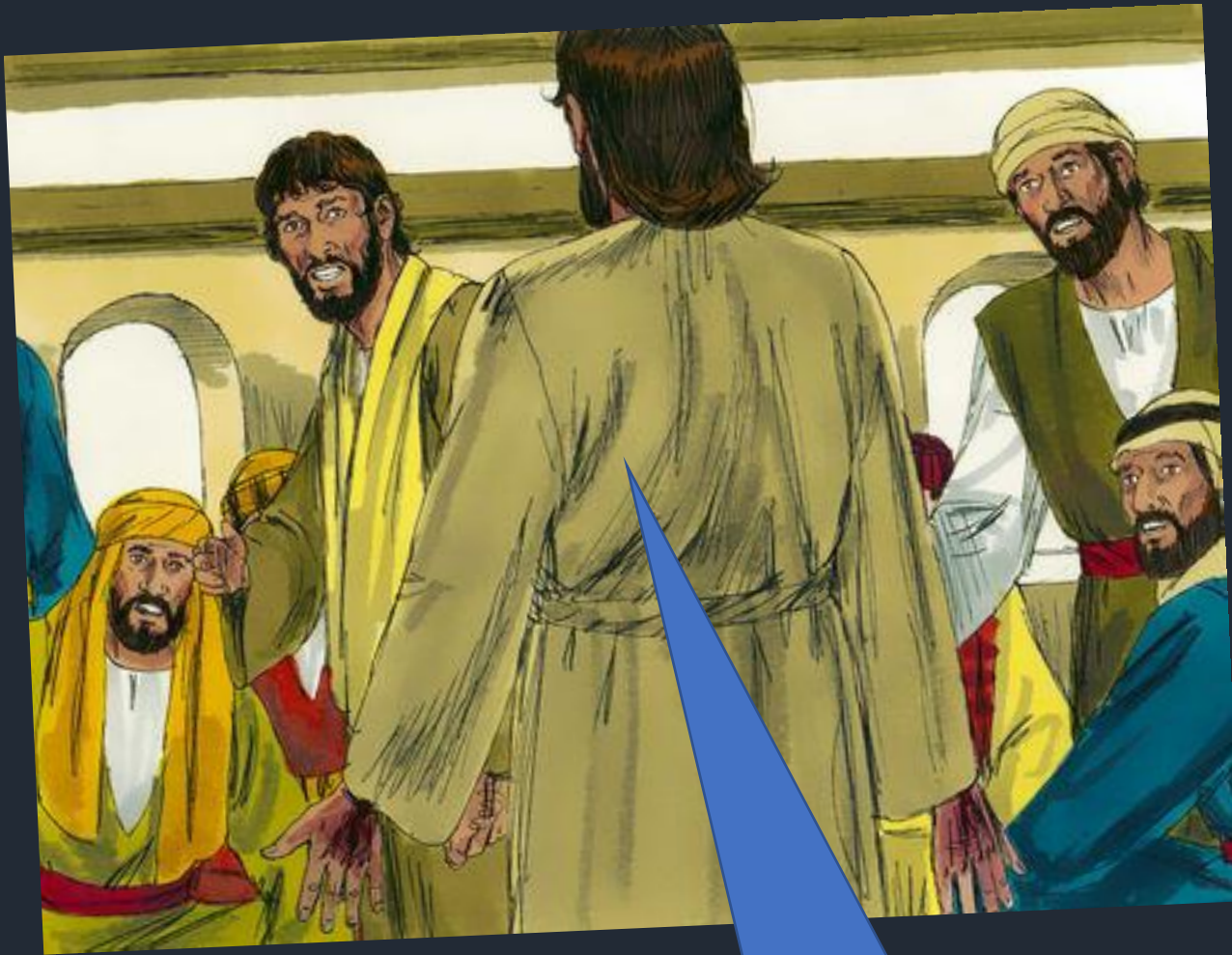

'Peace be with you!'

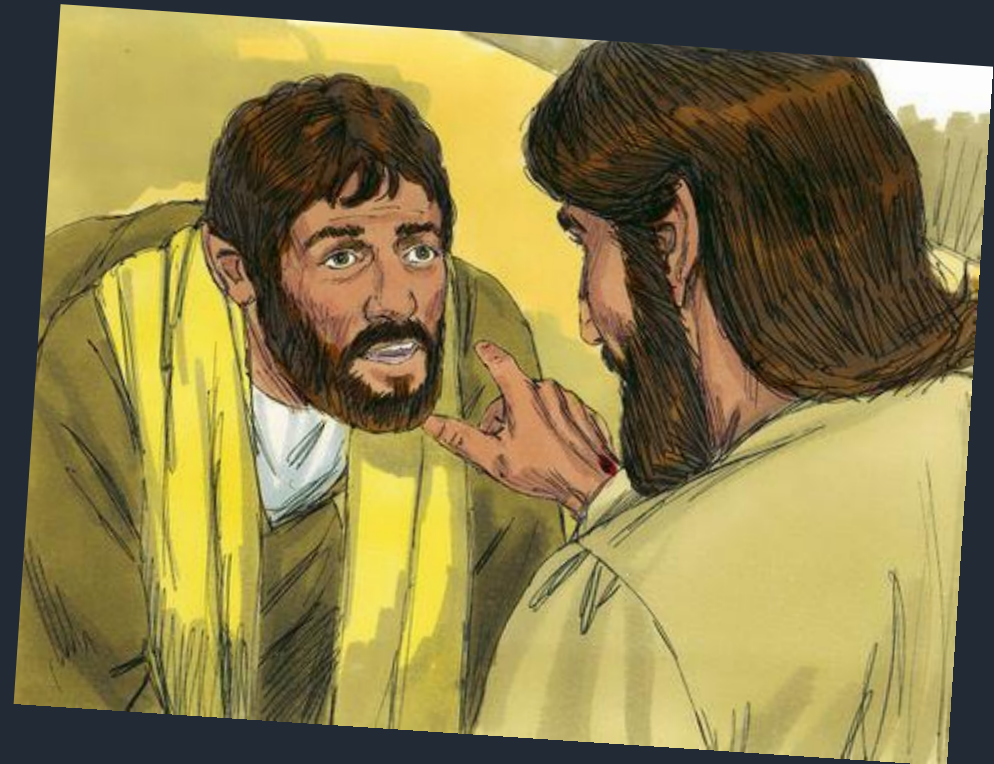
Then he said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe.'

She and some women took spices to the tomb early Sunday morning (Luke 24:1-10)



She was one of the women who provided for Jesus' needs (Mark 15:41)

She was the first to see the risen Jesus (Jn20)



She saw the tomb where Jesus was laid (Mt 27:61)

(i.e. she brought the good news of the risen JESUS to the Apostles)

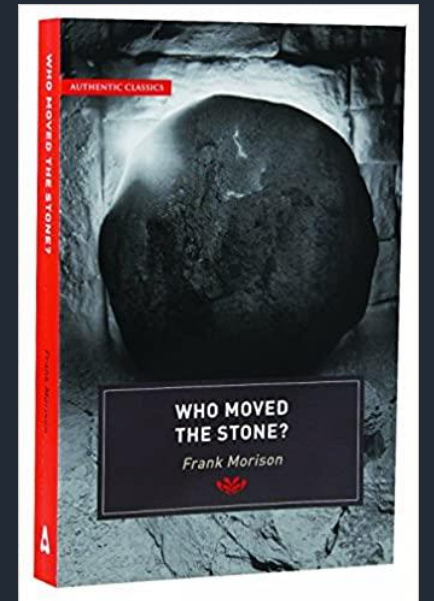


Thomas

Frank Morrison - a Modern-Day Thomas

Frank did not believe in Jesus. He wanted to prove Jesus did not rise from the dead. He researched & studied Jesus' trial, crucifixion & resurrection in detail. In the end he was convinced that Jesus rose from the dead. He started writing a book he did not intend to write.



Jesus Meets Us Where We Are !

Mary loved JESUS. She was there when he died on the cross. She went to the tomb early morning to bury him properly.

JESUS treasured her love and faithfulness. He appeared to her first and asked her to tell the other disciples, even though no one believed a woman's words in those days.

Thomas doubted. He wanted to see all the evidence before he would believe in JESUS.

JESUS welcomed his query and invited him to investigate. The Christian faith can stand inspection !
