## Question 16


#### Q: What is sin?

#### Bible verse (1 Jn 3:4)


Everyone who makes a practice of sinning also practices lawlessness; sin is lawlessness.

- □ The Bible is one big STORY of God's love for humanity
- □ Many stories in the big STORY are connected
- Today, we will learn how 3 stories are connected
- Can you guess what each of the 3 stories is about?

## First, we learnt about the Tower of Babel a few weeks ago. Remember what happened?

The Babylonians got together to build a city.

They even tried to use new technology to build a tower to reach the heavens !

Did they succeed in their building project?

□ If not, why not?



- God saw the city and the tower the people were building.
- He knew people's hearts were evil. People were proud and wanted to do things their own way. They rebelled against God by plotting together.
- God didn't want people's wickedness to multiply. He confused their languages so they could not plan wickedness together.
- People could not understand each other. So they stopped building the city and tower...
- □ And they scattered over the earth.

God confused people's languages

The project to build the Tower of Babel failed

People were scattered all over the world



#### But...what's wrong with trying to get back to God by our own way, like the Babylonians?

- God loves people and longs to be reunited with us.
- However, something must first be dealt with that is called "sin". Sin is rebellion against God.
  Sin separates people from God.
- The Babylonians tried to force their way to God without dealing with sin.
- Jesus is God's answer to sin. Jesus died for us and restores our relationship with God. There is no other way.




# The Holy Spirit

When we accept Jesus as our Saviour, God forgives us


God will even come to live in us !!!

## The Holy Spirit Came At Pentecost

- Last week we saw how the Holy Spirit came on the Day of Pentecost
- Because Pentecost was a big festival, many people came from all over to celebrate in Jerusalem
- Can you count the number of places people came from as mentioned in the Bible? (shown in yellow)



## The Holy Spirit Came At Pentecost

The Holy Spirit came, like tongues of fire and rested on the disciples !



- All the people who came to Jerusalem heard the disciples telling them God's wonders in their own language
- Peter stood up and told everyone about the good news of Jesus
- 3000 people believed that day. The Church was born !



- If you compare Babel and Pentecost, you will notice this :
- Pentecost is the opposite of Babel !
- Like FAT is the opposite of THIN, TALL is the opposite of SHORT
