#### Question 1

- Q: What is our only hope in life and death?
- A: That we are not our own but belong to God

#### This means that

- 1. We live to please God, not ourselves
- 2. We rely on God's Word to decide what is right or wrong


Bible verse: For none of us lives to himself, and none of us dies to himself. For if we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord. So then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's. (Rom. 14:7-8)

Jesus and his disciples were eating the Passover meal together. The disciples began to argue about which one of them was the greatest.



Luke 22:24-27

But Jesus said to them, "The kings of the world rule over their people. Men who have authority over others are called 'very important.'




But you must not be like that. The greatest among you should be like the youngest, and the leader should be like the servant.

Who is more important: the one sitting at the table or the one serving him? You think the one at the table is more important. But I am like a servant among you!

Remember a few weeks ago we learned about Jesus washing his disciples' feet?

He washed their feet one by one. He even dried them with a towel. His disciples were SHOCKED!!!

By washing their feet, Jesus showed them that to be great, you have to serve others.

# Eric Liddell A Great Athlete & Servant of God


- Eric was born in China to missionary parents
