In Jesus name, we pray. Amen.





When Jesus heard this he said, "This sickness will not end in death. It is for the glory of God. This has happened to bring glory to the Son of God."


Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. But when he heard that Lazarus was sick, he stayed where he was for two more days.




Jesus cried.



Family Discussion

1. How are Mary, Martha and Lazarus related? Do they love each other? Did Jesus feel the sadness of losing a loved one in the family?

2. John tells us that Jesus loved Lazarus. But when he heard Lazarus was sick, how long did he stay on before he went to see him? Why would Jesus delay if he really loved Lazarus?

3. Have you been impatient with God before? You prayed for something but God didn't answer right away...did you doubt his love?

Family Discussion

4. Reread what Jesus said. It is important. What words did Jesus repeat?

5. Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead! This powerful act reveals God's glory in Jesus. Does this show Jesus have power over death?

6. If Jesus could raise Lazarus from the dead, do you believe his words "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will have life even if he dies"?

Family Prayer Time

1. Thank God for His Word and help so we may learn from Jesus.

2. Ask your children to pray for what they have learned just now.

3. Ask your family how you can pray for them specifically.
